Identifying and Inserting LinkBuilder FDDI Workgroup Hub Modules

Before you insert any modules into the LinkBuilder FDDI Workgroup Hub chassis, please fill out and return the attached Product Registration Card to ensure that your product is covered under the 3Com® Corporation warranty.



CAUTION: Each module is packed in an antistatic bag to protect it during shipment. To avoid damaging any highly static-sensitive components on the module or the chassis, be sure to reduce any static electricity on your person. One way to do this is to touch the metal part of the chassis. You can maintain grounding by wearing a wrist strap attached to the chassis.

Refer to the *LinkBuilder FDDI Workgroup Hub User Guide*, which is supplied with the hub chassis, for detailed module installation instructions.

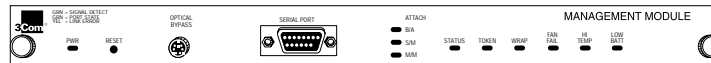


Figure 1. Management Module (Slot 0)

The Management module (Figure 1) must be inserted in slot 0 of the LinkBuilder FDDI Workgroup Hub.

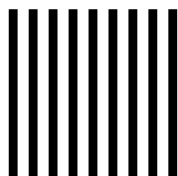
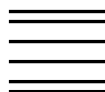
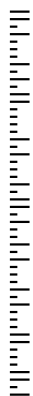

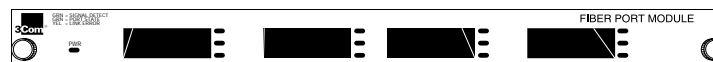


Figure 2. Fiber Port Module (Slot 1, 2, or 3)

The Fiber port module (Figure 2) can be inserted in slots 1, 2, or 3. Do not leave any slot empty between modules.

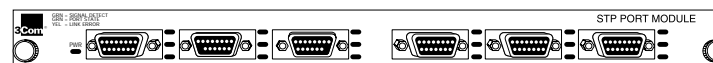


Figure 4. STP Port Module (Slot 1, 2, or 3)

The STP port module (Figure 4) can be inserted in slots 1, 2, or 3. Do not leave any slot empty between modules.
