Quick Reference to Using the ScanJet Plus scanner

Quick Steps to Image Scanning Using Scanning Gallery Plus 5.0 Software

Quick Steps to Image Scanning Using Desk Gallery Plus Software

- 1. From the SCANGAL5 directory, type WIN.
- 2. Double-click on SCANGAL5.EXE to open Scanning Gallery Plus 5.0.
- 3. Place the document face down on the copyboard glass with the top-right corner of the page next to the orange document set mark.
- 4. Drag the **Image type** pop-up menu to select the appropriate image type.
- 5. Click Preview scan.
- 6. Drag the mouse to create a selection box around the desired part of the image.
- 1. Place the image on the copyboard glass face down with the top of the image next to the orange V.
- 2. Select **DeskScan** from the Apple menu.
- 3. Click on the **Preview** button.
- 4. Drag the mouse to create a selection box for the desired part of the image.
- 5. Click on **Zoom** to see a closeup of the selected area.

- 7. Click Auto exposure.
- 8. Drag the **Resolution** pop-up menu to select a resolution to match your printer.
- **9.** Scale the image to the appropriate size.
- 10. From the **Print** menu, select **Copy print** to see a printout of your image, if desired.
- 11. Click Scan region.
- 12. Name the file.
- 13. Click Save.
- 6. Select a file format from the Scan To pull-down menu.
- 7. Select an image type.
- 8. Select a resolution to match your printer.
- **9.** Adjust brightness and contrast, if desired.
- **10.** Adjust the size of the final image, if desired.
- 11. Click on Final.
- 12. Name the scanned file. Click on **Save**.



Quick Steps to Text Scanning Using HP AccuScan Software

"One Button" Text Scanning Using the ADF

- 1. Place originals, text side up, top first into the ADF document tray. Adjust the document guide so that it touches the side of the paper stack.
- **2.** Slide the paper stack forward as far as it will go into the ADF cover.
- 3. Select Unattended.
- 4. Click Start.
- 5. After all the pages have been scanned, click **Done**.
- 6. Click File.
- 7. Select a file type.
- 8. Name the file.
- 9. Click Save.

Using the Region Tools

• Click the **Delete** tool, then click the text region you want to delete.

- Click the **Region** tool. Click and drag the mouse to create a new region.
- Click the **Notch** tool, then click a text region. Drag borders to shape the text region precisely.
- Select 2x, 4x, or Maximum zoom from the Zoomview menu to see an enlarged view of the document, if desired.

Interactive or Manual Text Scanning

- 1. Place any document with the text side down on the copyboard glass.
- 2. Select Interactive or Manual.
- 3. Click Start.
- 4. After making adjustments using the region tools, click **Continue**.
- 5. Click View to see the scanned text file, if desired.
- 6. Click Done.
- 7. Select a file type.
- 8. Name the file.
- 9. Click Save.

The scanner supports many text scanning packages. Encourage your customers to select the text-scanning product that best meets their needs. We recommend testing representative documents using the HP ScanJet Plus scanner and different text-scanning products. The automatic document feeder is a recommended option for text scanning.

HP offers a text-scanning product which works on AT-compatibles or MicroChannel computers. An 80286 processor is required, but 80386SX or 80386 is recommended. Scanning Gallery Plus 5.0 and a full version of Microsoft Windows 2.11 or 3.0 are required.
